Project Description

Background

In Europe we can see that mobility is increasing, and the result is we can have in the same place (work, classes, home), at same time, very diverse people: gender, age, race, social class, religion, culture, and so on. It is necessary to know how to deal and make the most of this diversity. The trainers and teachers of adults are considered agents of policy and change since they can reach and work new skills in many people, in effective way. The new role of adult educator as facilitator of learning includes the management of diversity, as well as ICT and research skills which needs to be developed in many European countries.

Project Aims

The LEARN+ projects aims at developing a course on diversity management, focussing on the following seven pedagogical key elements: diagnosis, pedagogical resources, language, pedagogical relationship, leadership, self-questioning, and formative assessment.

The course will be build according to constructivist model, to ensure the appropriation of the new skills: the learners will engage in research on new Adult Educator role, will work in teams to elaborate a project. And it will be blended so learners can develop ICT skills and learn at their own pace. The learning package includes a self-assessment system, project guide, tutorial programme and course manual, all available on CD-Rom in all partners' languages.

Results

To build this course the partnership will have

- to research on the subject,
- to produce a learning package and CD-Rom,
- to run pilot courses in four European countries, and
- to validate the final products.
