Project Description

It is essential for modern organisations and enterprises to develop systematic and methodical mechanisms for knowledge management, so as to be able to record corporate knowledge and information assets and to combine in an optimum way the existing knowledge for enhanced performance of their everyday business operations. They also need to develop resources and methods for the cultivation and facilitation of the existing knowledge diffusion.
